

1. Who were the previous auditors?

Moss, Krusick & Associates (Fiscal years ending June 30, 2020, 2021, and 2022)

- 2. Were there any disputes with management? No.
- 3. What are the budgeted fees [for the previous auditor]? \$17,750/year for auditing services and \$1,500/year for Tax Filing (Form 990).
- **4.** What was the last audit completed? Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022.
- 5. Can you provide us with an electronic copy of the 6/30/22 audited financial statements and the most recently completed Form 990?

- 6. How long has the current or previous auditor been performing ELC's audits? Three years.
- 7. Will the current or previous audit firm be allowed to submit a proposal? Yes.
- 8. Does ELC have an auditor rotation policy? If so, what is the policy?

  Yes. The Auditor Selection policy states ELC shall review the selection of its independent auditor "every 5 years to ensure competitive pricing and a high quality of service (this is not a requirement to change auditors every five years; simply to re-evaluate the selection)." ELC may issue an RFP sooner if the current auditor has a shorter-term contract.
- 9. What is the reason for the RFP?

ELC's previous auditor recently completed its most recent contract that included Fiscal Years ending June 30, 2020, 2021, and 2022. ELC's new multi-year contract will exceed Florida's Category II threshold (\$35,000) and requires ELC to employ a competitive procurement methodology.

- **10.** Do you prefer for the auditor to perform their work on-site or remotely? Remotely. However, ELC will arrange for the selected auditor to perform work on-site when necessary.
- 11. What accounting system is currently being used by ELC? Are any significant changes expected in the next three years?

ELC currently uses Abila MIP and has not made any plans to change the accounting system in the foreseeable future.

12. Is the prior auditor being considered for re-appointment?

All interested CPAs and auditing firms, including ELC's most recent auditor, who submit timely proposals, will be considered for an appointment. ELC will publicly open proposals received timely at **5:01 P.M. on August 16, 2023.** 

- 13. Are all accounting functions performed in one office, on one system? If not, how many accounting systems and locations are involved?
  - Yes—ELC uses Abila MIP for its accounting functions.
