



Request for Quotes for Management Training Facilitator Services Notice of Intent to Award (NOIA)

Proposal Evaluation and Selection Information:

The Early Learning Coalition of the Big Bend Region, Inc. (ELC) electronically notified seventeen (17) vendors specializing in non-profit management training and posted its **Request for Quotes (RFQ) for Facilitator and Training Services** on its official website on **April 11, 2025**.

ELC received **seven (7)** timely proposals by the publicly noticed deadline of **April 28, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.** The RFQ process was paused from **May 6, 2025, to June 6, 2025**, due to unanticipated circumstances. Upon resumption, the proposals were distributed to an evaluation team (“Eval Team”) for review.

Each proposal was independently evaluated and scored by **three Eval Team members** using the same scoring rubric. Upon completion of the scoring process, ELC calculated the **average score** for each proposal and ranked them in **descending order** (from highest to lowest average score).

To be considered **Eligible for Funding**, proposals were required to achieve a **minimum average score of 80**.

A **Notice of Intent to Award (NOIA)** will be issued to the Proposer with the highest-ranking eligible proposal. If the selected Proposer declines the NOIA or an agreement cannot be reached during contract negotiations, ELC reserves the right to extend a NOIA to the **next highest-scoring eligible Proposer**, continuing in this manner until an award is accepted.
